SESSION 1	WHY "Love Your Neighbor?"	Rationale for this course & its distinctives; our basic motive for going to them with the gospel; preparation for temple field trip during/after the seminar
SESSION 2	The Hindu PIZZA	Analysis of common features of Hindu beliefs, practices and philosophy; setting foundation for good attitudes towards our Hindu friends
SESSION 3	Crucial SKILLS in Witnessing (Part 1): Initiating Spiritual Conversations	How to initiate spiritual conversations using a three-part outline (with practice of these skills)
SESSION 4	Crucial SKILLS in Witnessing (Part 2): Unlearning Christianese	Discussion of common mistakes in witnessing, including a long list of vocabulary that communicates poorly or even creates barriers to understanding; how to share about your experiences with Jesus with practice
SESSION 5	Crucial SKILLS in Witnessing (Part 3): Overcoming Obstacles	Consideration of common obstacles in sharing the Gospel with Hindus, including those Christians have built, along with suggestions for responses (with practice of the most common one)
SESSION 6	Who Thinks What about Whom (Part 1): What Hindus Think about Their Own Religious Traditions	A group discussion session of insights into Hinduism from the personal reflections of Hindus themselves
SESSION 7	Who Thinks What about Whom (Part 2): What Hindus Think about Christians & Christianity	"Listen" to Hindus by reading their articles & watching a video to understand the barriers that Hindus have to the Gospel
SESSION 8	Who Thinks What about Whom (Part 3): What Christians Think about Hindus	Continues the task of breaking down our stereotypes & common misconceptions about Hindus; this session is not taught but articles fill a section in the notebook.
SESSION 9	The ABCDs of Going	This session examines what

		appropriate contextualization among Hindus might look like. [NOTE: The "Advanced Love Your
		Neighbor" workshop takes off from Sessions 9-11 and trains participants to begin using these specific skills with their Hindu friends by leading Yeshu satsangs - "Jesus Truth Gatherings".]
SESSION 10	The Power of Story	Focuses on which attributes most commonly attract Hindus to Christ and the appropriate Bible stories for each; practical tips and a practice for sharing the stories. Includes a specific Set of Bible Stories that has been found helpful.
SESSION 11	FOLLOWING UP Seekers and New Believers	Analysis of common patterns of Hindus progressing toward exclusive faith in Christ. Practical emphasis on how to disciple new believers, especially through challenges to their young faith.
SESSION 12	Strategies that Work, Tools that Build Confidence	A bridge from seminar to real life: Strategies and Tools offered by Naya Jeevan for continuing the learning and putting it into practice
